



BASIC SOM QUESTIONS By Rev. Michael Laakso

We have an on-going column which is designed to answer some basic Science of Mind questions. We trust this will give you new insights, allowing you to better understand SOM principles.

What is Infinity? Part Thirty-Eight

Our last two articles have been examining how a Nineteenth Century New Thought Truth student would find their teaching in the Bible. A few Eastern scriptures were beginning to be translated into English, but the Bible was the standard text for Westerners for spiritual study for most of that century. We made it to the Garden of Eden story and parsed through most of that parable. Some loose ends remain to consider.





Creation which is our spiritual creation as Mind individuated. The body is formed from the elements of the earth. The Breath of Life makes the body a living form now housing that invisible Air-beingness, air representing Spirit, the self-aware, conscious side of Mind. Adam begins naming everything he sees. Naming is labeling and labels actively separate Unity into nouns and verbs, forms and phenomena. Once labeled, the mind easily gives these an identity, always limited, a piece/part rather than a representation of the whole of its authoring Unity. In truth, all of Spirit is infinitely present in every point, form and phenomenon. Looking from Spirit, this vast unification is obvious. Mystics call this witnessing the Perfection of all that is.

Adam cannot find himself a companion. The Law/Lord puts him to sleep. Adam's thought is the Law/Lord of his life experience. His distancing himself from his Source consciousness by the act of naming — "chopping up" Unity—he loses consciousness. Nowhere does it say that Adam awakens. This indicates he lives in an unconscious state, unaware of the Truth, his Creator, and his own Nature, one with its Creator. As he dreams, his natural androgyny seems to split into a separate male and a separate female. Adam is on an internal adventure; what Joseph Campbell called the "Hero's journey."

The Garden, Eden, is a place where everything needed for a good life is effortlessly supplied. Truth students speak of the "Edenic Consciousness," meaning a mind-set of welcoming our Good with gratitude but also conscious companionship with our Source Mind (for which we were created). As Divine Mind creates effortlessly, our Edenic consciousness mirrors God's Mind state and the right Good appears at the right time free from struggle, lawfully and *apparently* miraculously, the normal state in Eden.

We examined the two thinking systems at the center of the Garden, symbolized by two trees. A tree is a wonderful symbol for a thought system: its roots are underground, in the subconscious, and the trunk represents the central idea or organizing principle, which then splits up into individual perceptions as that idea is applied to each event or object witnessed. We perceive based on our central thought, essentially projecting that idea onto the "screen" of our environment. These mind experiences are all the branch and twig ends, reaching out and "touching" the world.

The trees are named the Tree of Life and the Tree of the "knowledge" of Good and evil. The Trees indicate their central Thought in their names. From the Seven Days of Creation, we saw the creation of the physical environment, but more so the creation of every living thing. Like produces like, so God is Life since life comes of Its creating. We know God is Unity, being All Good. The Tree of Life represents the thought of Livingness; though its manifestations may look diverse, all demonstrate the One Life. Also from the Seven Days of Creation, we know only Good is Real. So "knowing" evil, the contradiction of Good, cannot be a possibility. Only the Real can be known and is always known by direct contact with no go-between. Moreover, evil cannot be Real since we learned only Good exists, as God declared the Whole of His creating. These two points show the second tree represents a thinking system of absurdities; of ideas that cannot be actually known because they are absolutely unreal.



So we have a thinking system of delusion on one hand and a thinking system of aliveness, Reality, sanity on the other. One is a dualistic system and the other is nondual, Unified. It is probably important to mention here that there are no illusions in the world. All illusions are in the mind, which goes on to think it sees them as realities in the world. Illusions are the result of a dualistic idea of Life and Self.

We examined the snake/temptation story. In this dream journey, what does the snake represent? From the dualistic viewpoint, the snake is the Enemy of God, Satan. The word "satan" means hater or accuser. Don't we all have an accusing voice in our minds, a voice that hates this and hates that? A voice that gets offended and upset, is touchy and high maintenance. To me this is ego's voice, and ego is not an "entity" but an idea of what I am, a limited, fragile, untrue idea. Hence its defensiveness. Ernest Holmes comments that there are many voices in the subconscious mind – and many of them are negative and negating. From the Unity viewpoint, this is unquiet mental energy that propels the journey forward. Consider that Adam sleeps, due to his separatist thinking. Temptation has already triumphed. The snake simply establishes what has already happened in mind: dualism. Adam split up the living into categories, differentnesses. Adam set this inner energy in motion already. His assuming the dualistic viewpoint has already begun. Now it becomes official, that is, named.

What this illustrates is mind's tendency to take what is given it and automatically expand that to the furthest implication. Mind naturally elaborates on whatever it is given. Consider Divine Mind's creation of all the varieties of life forms on earth. Life as Mind elaborated every environment with many kinds of life activities: fish, birds, reptiles and cattle in the waters, sky and land respectively. We cannot change how Mind operates, but knowing how it operates, we can select with care what we give our mind. Adam gave his mind the idea of apartness, separation, with his naming activity. God was his right and perfect Companion. He lost sight of his Source and that constant Love and Care in Whom he lives, moves and has his being.

Now, having integrated more completely the dualistic idea, he (and Eve, his internal feminine reflection) have their first negative emotion: shame. Nakedness is no shame in God's Mind Who hides nothing and accepts everything as Good and very Good. Adam has become self-conscious, in the sense of being flawed, not enough, wrong, like his body has impure parts, though it is God-created. Shame is just another of the negating, accusing subconscious voices. Adam and Eve cover that generative part of their body. Hiding is another sign of ego, the false idea of self. God hides nothing, is completely honest and transparent in all senses. It is the all Good. What's to hide, and why?

"In the cellars of the night, when the mind s moving around old trunks of bad times, the pain of this and the shame of that, the memory of a small boldness is a hand to hold." ~John Leonard

More so, Adam is ashamed of his body. This flags his identification with his physical vehicle. Limitless Spirit is thinking it is a bounded form. This is how ego operates. This false idea of our self substitutes a body/form for the formless Identity Infinite Mind created as us. How we identify our selves is determinate of how we see life, others, the world environment. Adam now identifies with his body – dust – and has lost his awareness of the spiritual Identity – breath/Spirit – that he actually is. Adam has internalized falsehood and the consequences continue to unfold.

Adam used to experience God intermittently, if also daily, "walking in the Garden at the time of the evening breeze..." This communing used to be always, but naming truncated that conscious contact. Now, when the sound of God's walking is heard, they hide themselves. Running away from God, feeling shame, is a consequence of dualistic thinking and untrue self-identification. Having judged themselves inadequate, they projected onto God that judger and became afraid of their Creator. Again, hiding is a sign of the ego. "We are as sick as our secrets," we hear in 12-step rooms. Thinking oppositely from God, our joy in that relationship is an early casualty.

God feels the retreat and asks questions with obvious answers but the *retreaters* are in need of acknowledging what they did. Interestingly, their answers show their continuing innocence. They don't lie. They are still novices at this duality thing.

Next come the "curses." To the serpent the Lord said:

'On your belly you shall crawl and dust shall you eat all the days of your life.
I will put enmity between you and the woman, between your brood and hers.
They shall strike at your head.
And you shall strike at their heel.'

To the woman he said:

'I will increase your labor and your groaning, And in labor you shall bear children. You shall feel an urge for your husband, And he shall be your master.'

And to the man he said,

'Because you have listened to your wife
And have eaten from the tree which I forbade you,
Accursed shall be the ground on your account.
With labor you shall win your food from it
All the days of your life.
It will grow thorns and thistles for you,
none but wild plants for you to eat.
You shall gain your bread by the sweat of your brow
Until you return to the ground;
For from it you were taken.
Dust you are, to dust you shall return.'

We need to point out that Divine Mind never curses but only blesses. Using the Nondual viewpoint, this is obvious. Divine Mind, being infinite, has only one side, an inside of total Goodness. Being infinite, It cannot comprehend cursing or condemning, but only creative blessing that loves and blesses all. However, when we take on the dualistic viewpoint, cursing seems logical and inevitable. We curse ourselves by the untrue, unloving thoughts we think about our selves and everything else.

Essentially, these words declare the collapse of the Edenic experience. The Edenic consciousness has been interrupted and though Eden continues as a potential experience, Adam's current consciousness has exempted him from experiencing it. Enmity has been introduced where before only Harmony was. Pain has been introduced where before only Peace was. Struggle is introduced where before complete Ease was. These consequences indicated to a 19th Century Truth student the action of the Law of Mind and are both cautionary and promising; cautionary for the obvious loss of Harmony, Peace, and Ease, but also promising for tracing out the thinking that produced that loss. Reversing the process is the way back to Eden! And Truth students were interested in finding solutions to the strife, pain and struggle in their own lives as well as the lives of others. Hence the practice of re-identifying our selves with Source Mind and Its many Attributes; and affirming this True Identity consistently as the way back, and paradoxically the way forward.

After the Lord/Law cast Adam and Eve out of Eden, 'to the east of Eden he stationed the cherubim and a sword whirling and flashing to guard the way to the Tree of Life.' The concern here was to prevent Adam from making his dualistic state permanent. The dualistic mind sees this as further punishment. In fact it is a mercy. The nondual mind desires Adam's fulfillment of his journey homeward and this ensures his current state be temporary. Adam will have to face these "temple guardians" on his way back to his beginnings, now armed with wisdom and a clearing consciousness. These act as filters to ensure the homeward travelers are prepared to deal with their first errors and so can pass through in safety. Otherwise, they are repelled for more learning and experience.

This journey must come full circle, for incompletion is an impossibility in the Mind of God. The experience of separation must find its resealing in Oneness recognized and lived. No separation has occurred. We only think it has. As we shift our thinking from dualistic to Unitary, we waken from the dream of apartness and see Reality has not changed. Jesus retells this story as the parable of the Prodigal Son. He scotches the guilt and shame, the trappings of dualistic thinking. A son merely wanders off, learns his error by experience and determines to come home. He is met with jubilation. And so are we.





